**TAB 8 - Staff Concerns on Chapter 458.347(7) regarding one-time extension versus one year extension of temporary license**

Ms. Prine addressed the Council regarding several cases of temporary licensees having failed the initial NCCPA examination, requested and was granted a one time extension of temporary license to retake the first available examination, but failed to do so. Ms. Gerbert explained to the Council the history of the examination administration and the time frames allowed for taking the examination. It was the opinion of Ms. Gerbert that the one time extension of the license would be for one year. Dr. Cline stated concerns of allowing an extension without reviewing the examination and employment history of the applicant. It was recommended that an application be developed for those requesting an extension of the temporary certificate. The Committee discussed information that should be requested with the application. Ms. Prine asked the Council to table to allow staff to develop an application. The motion was moved and carried.
