**TAB 6 – Review of Rule 64B8-30.015, FAC – Disciplinary Guidelines**

Mr. Tellechea explained to the Council that the disciplinary guidelines need to be updated because statutory grounds for discipline have changed, but not the guidelines. He stated the Board of Medicine was revising their disciplinary guidelines to include community service and CME.

A motion was made, seconded and carried unanimously to authorize Mr. Tellechea to notice this rule for development, to draft proposed changes and to present the proposed language at the next meeting.

**TAB 7 – Review of Rule 64B8-30.014(3)(a), FAC – Citation Authority**

Ms. Sanford explained that citations are issued for failing to complete the required CME for renewal and one of the penalties is that the licensee must submit his/her CME prior to renewal for the following two (2) renewal periods. The Medical Compliance Officer indicated difficulty tracking these citations. She explained this is a process problem because licensees often wait until late in the renewal period to submit the CME and then miss the renewal deadline. She suggested the language state the licensee will be audited for the next biennium or two (2) biennium's.

A motion was made, seconded and carried unanimously to authorize Mr. Tellechea to notice this rule for development, to draft language to reflect the licensee will be audited for the next two (2) biennium's following issuance of the citation and to present the draft language at the next meeting.

Action taken: notice for rule development and bring draft language to the next meeting

**New Business:**

Ms. Gerbert asked the Council if an applicant undergoes a PRN evaluation and if contract is not needed and there are no other issues, no appearance is required.

Ms. Gerbert then asked if an applicant is under a contract with PRN and in compliance at the time of application and there is no other issue besides the impairment, no appearance is required. The Committee agreed but stressed if there were other issues besides the impairment, an appearance would be required.

The Council reiterated that staff has discretion as to whether to require an applicant to appear or not and to work with the Chair.

**Action taken:** Staff and Chair have discretion regarding appearances

Ms. Gerbert asked the Council whether the rule regarding the requirement for submission of letters of reference needed to be modified. The Council agreed this has been successfully handled in the past with petitions for waiver or variance and there are not many of these requests; therefore, no changes to the rule are necessary.

**Action taken:** none

The Council discussed the request for a workshop regarding the PA Formulary scheduled for November 6, 2008 in Tampa. Some members were unsure if they were available on that date. After discussion it was determined that a quorum of the Council was not required for the workshop.
