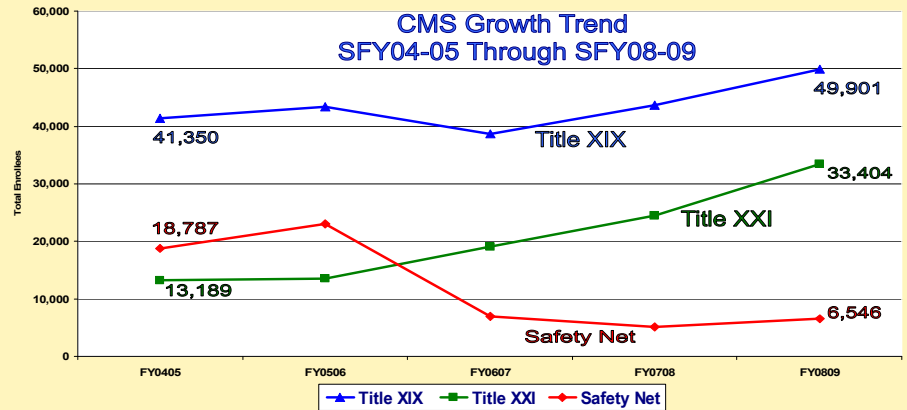
## Children's Medical Services

### Health Care for Children with Special Needs

## Services within CMS Network

**Children's Medical Services (CMS) Network** provides a range of medical, therapeutic and supportive services to children with special health care needs their families through one of the 22 area offices around the state. Available services include prevention and intervention services, primary care, medical and therapeutic specialty care, and long term care.

Our statewide network includes over 5,000 doctors, hospitals, university medical centers and other healthcare providers who are all specially qualified to meet your child's unique health care needs. Medical care is provided at community doctors' offices and hospitals, local specialty medical clinics, and university medical centers. CMS Network is also a proud part of Florida KidCare, Florida's State Child Health Insurance Program (SCHIP).



**In addition to providing health care services to children and young adults through a managed system of care, the CMS Network provides services through the following programs:**

- The **Primary Care** program provides CMS patients with a medical home where they can receive sick and well-child care, immunizations, testing, prescription drugs, and support.
- The **Regional Perinatal Intensive Care Centers** provide obstetrical services to women who have a high-risk pregnancy and care for newborns with special health needs, such as critical illness or low birth weight.
- **Medical Foster Care** is a home-based program for children who have complex medical conditions and are unable to live with their families. Medical foster parents provide personal care services for these children and train the birth family on how to care for their child's special medical needs so the child can return home.
- The **Brain and Spinal Cord Injury Program** provides eligible Florida residents who sustain a moderate-to-severe brain or spinal cord injury the opportunity to receive care and treatment that will help them return to their home and community.
